Sequim - Sequim/Dungeness	4.66 mi. / 9 min.
Sequim/Dungeness - Port Angeles (Olympic Cellars) via Old Olympic Hwy.	10.9 mi. / 20 min.
Olympic Cellars - Wildfire Grill (Port Angeles)	8.75 mi. / 15 min.
Port Angeles - Lake Crescent (Marymere Falls) via Hwy. 101 W	19.6 mi. / 25 min.
Lake Crescent - Neah Bay via WA-112 Strait of Juan de Fuca Scenic Highway	61 mi. / 2 hrs.+
Neah Bay - Quinault	117 mi. / 2 hrs. 40 min.
Quinault - Hoquiam	40.26 mi. / 51 min.

Seattle – Lilliwaup via Hwy. 101, Pacific Coast Scenic Byway	110.5 mi. / 2 hrs.
Seattle – Port Ludlow via Seattle / Winslow Ferry	36.63 mi. / 1 hr. 35 min.
Everett – Port Ludlow via Edmonds / Kingston Ferry (30 min. cross.)	44.25 mi. / 1 hr. 30 min.
Coupeville – Port Townsend via Coupeville Ferry (35 min. cross.)	10.96 mi. / 46 min.

Seattle – Neah Bay, I-5 N to WA-112 via Edmonds / Kingston Ferry	154.82 mi. / 4 hr. 15 min.
Seattle – Neah Bay via I-5 S to WA-112	207.88 mi. / 4 hr. 35 min.
Seattle - Aberdeen via I-5 S	108.91 mi. / 2 hrs

Note: Hwy. 112, the Strait of Juan de Fuca Scenic Byway, is a slow-going 61- mile stretch of road enveloped in natural scenic beauty. Allow 2 hours to drive the byway without stopping, longer to stop and enjoy the views of rugged coastline and rocky bluffs, or to catch a glimpse of eagles diving, gray whales spouting and otters splashing.
